

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

This chapter presents: Conclusions, and ,suggestions based on the findings and interpretation in the previous chapter.

A. Conclusions

Based on the result of data analysis and the discussion of the result in previous chapter, the finding of the result showed the positive impact in the students' pronunciation in English consonant. This study is categorized pre-experiment research design, the objective in this study is to find out whether or not use BBC Learning English Application is able to improve students' pronunciation in English consonant at Lintasan Imajinasi Bahasa Mahasiswa (LIBAM) of IAIN Parepare. Therefore, the researcher concluded that using BBC Learning English Application was effective to improve students' pronunciation in English consonant there was a significant difference of the students' pronunciation in English consonant after treatment.

The following are the description of the conclusion based on the problem statement of this research:

For the first research problem, using BBC English Learning Application effective to improve students' pronunciation in English consonant at Lintasan Imajinasi Bahasa Mahasiswa (LIBAM) IAIN Parepare. It is prove by rejecting of null hypothesis (H_0) and accepting of alternative hypothesis. In the results of the t-test that has been done, it is found that H_0 is rejected and H_a is accepted. These results are obtained by calculating (df) is $N-1$ so, $20-1 = 19$, for $\alpha = 0.05$ and $df = 19$. The t table shows the t table value of 1.729. By comparing the results obtained from the calculation, it can be seen that t count is greater than t table, where t count = 1.784 while t table = 1.729. Based on these calculations, the t count is

greater than the t table, thus the alternative hypothesis (H_a) is accepted and this means that the use of the BBC Learning English application is effective in improving students' pronunciation skills at LIBAM IAIN Parepare.

B. Suggestions

In respect to the conclusion for the improvement of students' English achievement in learning pronunciation, the researcher give some suggestion as followed:

1. For the Committee of LIBAM

LIBAM committees should use the BBC Learning English application as a media in providing English lesson material during routine lessons every week because the use of media such as applications has proven to be effective in helping to improve students' pronunciation skills and make students more enthusiastic about learning because the learning process becomes more fun. In addition, administrators can also continue the learning process that has been carried out by researchers because researchers have not had the chance to explain how consonants are pronounced properly and correctly as a whole due to limited research time.

2. For the Students

With this application, researchers hope that students can be even more enthusiastic about learning. The many features available in this application can be used by students to further improve their English skills because the BBC Learning English application can not only be used for learning pronunciation but also for learning vocabulary and grammar. Students can learn with the ease of accessing this application anytime and anywhere.
